


Ring Size Guide


Option 1 - Print and Trim Ring Sizer

Print at 100% making sure to uncheck the "fit to page" option on your print screen. Cut out the sizer. Create a slot in the sizer by cutting along the dotted line. Roll the sizer into a circle with the numbers on the outside. Insert the end of the tab into the slot. Place the sizer around your finger and pull the tab through the slot until the paper is snug around your finger. Read your finger size on the scale. Be sure to check the size of your printout for accuracy!






This would read as 17.5



Option 2 - Measure an Existing Ring

Place an existing ring over the circles below. The edge of the circle should be barely visible through the ring's inner circumference. **Be sure to check the size of your printout for accuracy!**





Note: When printed out at actual size, this chart should provide an accurate representation of ring sizes. To be 100% sure that you are looking at the correct size, place a quarter in the circle at left or measure the square at right. If your print is the wrong size, check your print settings to be sure that "fit to page" is not selected.
